The children come from Monday to Friday every week, to learn about God's grace and favor through **daily devotional**. They worship and read the Bible with Carol or other staff members. They pray for their families, for Guatemala and for their prayer friends!



In order to support the **nutrition** of the children, around 12,000 nutritious meals were served by the ministry during the pandemic. Through good nutrition, children will improve their health, reduce the risk of common illnesses and grow in a better way!



The children who are attending Tabitha CarePoint must follow the new classroom protocols. They need to be wearing face mask and keep physical distance while they are in their classrooms **for education**. The teachers are doing a great job teaching the children, and they are giving their best to have the children achieve their goals and move to the next grade in 2021.
